Here we use the *free* "**BBO Bridge Master**" Level-5 **Lesson B-06** which gives you the opportunity to see and *repeatedly practice* playing a given bridge Board.

BBO Bridge Master Level 5 Lesson B-06

Dealer: **SOUTH**

NORTH (5)

S: Q 8 7 6 5
H: K 9 8
D: 6 4 2
C: 4 2

WEST (7)

S: J T
H: 3
D: K J T 9 8
C: Q T 9 8 7

EAST (5)

S: A 9 4 3
H: T 4 2
D: 7 5
C: J 6 5 3

SOUTH (23)

S: K 2
H: A Q J 7 6 5
D: A Q 3
C: A K

Bidding

SOUTH	WEST	NORTH	EAST
2 C	2 NT*	PASS	4 C**
4 H	PASS	5 H	PASS
6 H	PASS	PASS	PASS

*This bid is an "Unusual 2NT"² bid showing (1) 5+ cards in both Minors with (2) both Minors having good "Suit Quality".

**A bid of a Minor by EAST is required if EAST's RHO PASSES and shows the "longest and strongest" of EAST's 2 Minors.

On Trick #1 WEST leads his Spade Jack.

1. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed, how many "losers" should Declarer SOUTH see?

About 3.2% of randomly-deal bridge Hands involve a 5-5-2-1 distribution (any Suit order) and 0.9% of Hands involve a 5-5-3-0 distribution (any Suit order) so 4.1% of randomly-dealt Hands involve 2 5-card Suits. There are 6 2-Suit combinations: S,H, S,D, S,C, H,D, H,C, D,C. So, 4.1% / 6 = 0.7% of randomly-dealt Hands are 2 Suited 5-5 in the Minors. Furthermore, some of the very rare x-x-5-5 distributions you hold may have insufficient Honors to make an 'Unusual 2NT!' Overall bid rational. "Esther Bridge 'Pop' Quizzes, Play as Declarer, Suit Contracts" dealing with 'Unusual 2NT!' Overall bids are Quizzes #305, #303, #300, #271 and #250.

2. On Trick **#1** EAST (improvidently) "wins" with his Spade Ace.
What Spade should Declarer SOUTH play on Trick **#1**?
