Here we use the *free* "**BBO Bridge Master**" Level-5 **Lesson C-30** which gives you the opportunity to see and *repeatedly practice* playing a given bridge Board. Esther may have altered some of the cards in the Hands.

BBO Bridge Master Level 5 Lesson C-30

Dealer: **EAST**

NORTH (8)

S: A Q 5 3
H: Q 9 4
D: 8 7 6 5
C: T 5

WEST (4)

S: K J T 9 8
H: 8
D: T 9 4
C: 8 7 6 4

EAST (15)

S: 7 6
H: T 7 6
D: A Q 3 2
C: A K Q 9

SOUTH (13)

S: 4 2
H: A K J 5 3 2
D: K J
C: J 3 2

Bidding

EAST	SOUTH	WEST	NORTH
1 NT	2 H	2 S	3 H
PASS	4 H	PASS	PASS
PASS	PASS		

WEST leads the Diamond Ten thus "promising" either the "touching" Diamond 9 or a Diamond T,x doubleton. EAST "wins" Trick #1 with his Diamond Ace. On Trick #2 EAST leads the Trump Heart 6.

1. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed how many HCPs should Declarer SOUTH estimate that WEST holds?
2. What "losers" should Declarer SOUTH see?
3. After Trick #1 on which EAST played his Diamond Ace, where should Declarer SOUTH "place" the still "missing" Diamond Queen and Club A,K,Q?
4. Which E/W Opponent **must** the "missing" Spade King be held for Declarer SOUTH to have any chance to make his 4**H** contract?
