The "**BBO Bridge Master**" website allows you to declare your skill level, then shows a series of Hands and announces the final contract, each of which you then play as Declarer. At the end of play you can then request a solution in which the optimal "Line of Play" is discussed step by step. Here we use the *free* "**BBO Bridge Master**" Level-1 **Lesson A-13** which gives you the opportunity to see and *repeatedly practice* playing a given bridge Board. Esther may have altered some of the cards in the Hands.

Dealer: **SOUTH**

NORTH (12)

**S:** Q 5 3

**H:** 5 3 2

**D:** K 3 2

**C:** A Q J T

WEST (7)

**S:** A K T 7 6

**H:** 8 6 4

**D:** 6 4

**C:** 6 5 3

EAST (5)

**S:** J 9 8

**H:** A T 9 7

**D:** 8 7 5

**C:** 9 8 7

SOUTH (16)

**S:** 4 2

**H:** K Q J

**D:** A Q J T 9

**C:** K 4 2

**Bidding**

SOUTH

1NT

PASS

WEST

PASS

PASS

NORTH

3NT

EAST

PASS

WEST leads the Spade 7 on Trick #1.

1. How should Declarer SOUTH interpret WEST's lead of the Spade 7?
2. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed how many "winners" can Declarer SOUTH see?
3. What Spade card must Declarer SOUTH play from the NORTH Dummy on Trick #1?
