Here we use the *free* "**BBO Bridge Master**" Level-4 **Lesson A-27** which gives you the opportunity to see and *repeatedly practice* playing a given bridge Board. Esther may have altered some of the cards in the Hands.

BBO Bridge Master Level 4 Lesson A-27

Dealer: **SOUTH**

NORTH (10)

S: A 4 2
H: 4 2
D: K Q J T
C: 6 4 3 2

WEST (6)

S: Q 5 3
H: K J 3
D: 9 8 6
C: T 9 8 7

EAST (0)

S: T 9 8 7 6
H: T 8 7 6 5
D: 7 5
C: 5

SOUTH (24)

S: K J
H: A Q 9
D: A 4 3 2
C: A K Q J

Bidding

SOUTH	WEST	NORTH	EAST
2 C	PASS	2 D	PASS
2 NT	PASS	6 NT	PASS
PASS	PASS		

On Trick #1 WEST leads his Club Ten at the "top" of a "touching" card sequence. Declarer SOUTH "wins" Trick #1 with his own Club Jack.

1. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed what "winners" can Declarer SOUTH see?
2. Where does Declarer SOUTH hope that the "missing" Spade Queen and Heart K,J lie?
3. What are the probabilities of successful N/S finesses in the 2 Majors?
4. Is there a bridge "play" other than the bridge finesse that Declarer SOUTH can employ in order to "make" his 6**NT** contract?
