The "**BBO Bridge Master**" website allows you to declare your skill level, then shows a series of Hands and announces the final contract, each of which you then play as Declarer. At the end of play you can then request a solution in which the optimal "Line of Play" is discussed step by step. Here we use the *free* "**BBO Bridge Master**" Level-4 **Lesson B-25** which gives you the opportunity to see and *repeatedly practice* playing a given bridge Board. Esther may have altered some of the cards in the Hands.

Dealer: **SOUTH**

NORTH (9)

S: 6 5 4 3
H: 3 2
D: 3 2
C: A K Q 5 3

WEST (7)

S: T
H: K Q T 8
D: J T 9 7
C: J T 9 7

EAST (3)

S: 2
H: 9 7 6 5 4
D: K 8 6 5 4
C: 8 6

SOUTH (21)

S: A K Q J 9 8 7
H: A J
D: A Q
C: 4 2

Bidding

SOUTH	WEST	NORTH	EAST
2C	PASS	3C	PASS
4S	PASS	4NT*	PASS
5S**	PASS	7S	PASS
PASS	PASS		

*Asking for Aces.
**"Partner, I hold 3 Aces."

On Trick #1 WEST leads his Heart King thus "promising" "touching" Honors and "long" Hearts. Declarer SOUTH "wins" Trick #1 with his own Heart Ace.

1. What pedagogical benefit is there for having a bridge lesson about playing a 7S contract?
2. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed what "losers" can Declarer SOUTH see?
3. What "Lines of Play" can Declarer SOUTH consider using to secure his necessary 13th Trick?
