WEST leads his Diamond 2 as **4th** from the "top" of his "longest and strongest" Suit so that Partner EAST (and Declarer SOUTH) can use the "**Rule of 11**"² to determine exactly how many Diamonds higher than the Diamond 2 Declarer SOUTH (or EAST) holds.

1. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed what "winners" should Declarer SOUTH see?
2. Should Declarer SOUTH "cash" his "winners" early or later?
