Richard Pavlicek (1945-) has won **11** North American Bridge Championships, including a record-setting **3** straight wins in the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams, 1982-84, and again in 1990. He won the 1973 inaugural Grand National Teams tournament and repeated a win there in 1997. He has written or co-authored several bridge books, including with co-author William S. Root their 1981 book, Modern Bridge Conventions. From 1984 until 1990 Pavlicek was the Bridge Columnist for the Fort Lauderdale News and Sun-Sentinel. Bidding

NORTH	EAST	SOUTH	WEST
1 C	PASS	2 D	PASS
2 S	PASS	2 NT	PASS

5 H*	PASS	6 NT	DBL
PASS	PASS	PASS	

*"Partner, I hold 2 Aces."

WEST leads the Spade Ten as a "Passive" lead expecting that this lead can do no harm. Declarer SOUTH "wins" with the NORTH Dummy's Spade Ace.

1. Once the NORTH Dummy is exposed what "winners" can Declarer NORTH see?
